TEL Software License Terms

For all TEL Software, Inc. Software Products

These license terms are an agreement between TEL Software, Inc. ("TSI") and you the user of TEL Software purchased from TEL-Software, Inc., Tel electronics, Inc. or any affiliated company of TSI or TEL electronics, Inc. Please read them. These terms apply to the TEL software you use ("the "Software"). Printed license terms, which may come with the delivery of the Software or any of its updates and such terms may replace or modify any on-screen license terms. These terms also apply to all Software updates, supplements, Internet-based services, and support services for the Software, unless other terms expressly accompany those items. If so, those terms apply. BY USING THE SOFTWARE, YOU ACCEPT THESE TERMS. IF YOU DO NOT ACCEPT THEM, DO NOT USE THE SOFTWARE. INSTEAD, RETURN IT TO THE AUTHORIZED TEL DEALER A REFUND OR CREDIT. If you cannot obtain a refund there, contact TSI or the TSI affiliate serving you for information about TSI's refund policies. See www.TSI-software.com or call (1-800)748-5022. USING THE SOFTWARE ALSO OPERATES AS YOUR CONSENT TO THE TRANSMISSION OF CERTAIN COMPUTER INFORMATION DURING ACTIVATION, VALIDATION AND FOR INTERNET-BASED SERVICES. IF YOU COMPLY WITH THESE LICENSE TERMS, YOU HAVE THE RIGHTS BELOW FOR EACH LICENSE YOU ACQUIRE.

- 1. OVERVIEW. The software is licensed on a per copy per device basis. A hardware partition or blade is considered to be a separate device.
- 2. INSTALLATION AND USE RIGHTS. a. One Copy per Device. You may install one copy of the software on one device. That device is the "licensed device." b. Licensed Device. You may only use one copy of the software on the licensed device at a time. c. Portable Device. You may install another copy of the software on a portable device for use by the single primary user of the licensed device. d. Separation of Components. The components of the software are licensed as a single unit. You may not separate the components and install them on different devices. e. Alternative Versions. The software may include more than one version. You may install and use only one version at a time.
- 3. ADDITIONAL LICENSING REQUIREMENTS AND/OR USE RIGHTS. Other licensing requirements may apply for multiplexing or pooling, remote access, use of development tools, trial versions or subscription software.
- 4. ACTIVATION. Activation associates the use of the software with a specific device. Some versions of the software may have mandatory activation requirements. During activation, the software may send information about the software and the device to TSI. This information includes the version, the license version, language and product key of the software, the Internet protocol address of the device, and information derived from the hardware configuration of the device. BY USING THE SOFTWARE, YOU CONSENT TO THE TRANSMISSION OF THIS INFORMATION. If properly licensed, you have the right to use the version of the software installed during the installation process up to the time permitted for activation. UNLESS THE SOFTWARE IS PROPERLY ACTIVATED, YOU MAY HAVE LIMITED USAGE RIGHTS TO THE SOFTWARE. This is to prevent its unlicensed use. YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BYPASS OR CIRCUMVENT ACTIVATION WHEN REQUIRED. Activation requirements will be provided to you by TSI.
- 5. VALIDATION. a. The software may from time to time request download of the validation feature of the software. Validation verifies that the software has been activated and is properly licensed. A validation check confirming that you are properly licensed permits you to use the software, certain features of the software or to obtain additional benefits b. During or after a validation check, the software may send information about the software, the device and the results of the validation check to TSI. This information includes, for example, the version and product key of the software and the Internet protocol address of the licensed device. TSI does not use the information to identify or contact you. BY USING THE SOFTWARE, YOU CONSENT TO THE TRANSMISSION OF THIS INFORMATION. c. If, after a validation check, the software is found to be counterfeit, improperly licensed, or a non-genuine Office product then the functionality or experience of using the software may be affected. For example, d. TSI may provide notice that the software is improperly licensed or a non-genuine Office product; and you may receive reminders to obtain a properly licensed copy of the software; or need to follow TSI's instructions to be licensed to use the software and reactivate; and you may not be able to use or continue to use the software or some of the features of the software; or obtain certain updates or upgrades from TSI. e. You may only obtain updates or upgrades for the software from TSI or authorized sources.

- 6. INTERNET-BASED SERVICES. TSI provides Internet-based services with the software. It may change or cancel them at any time. If you use the TEL or TSI Internet-based services you CONSENT TO THE TRANSMISSION OF INFORMATION relate to such services. TSI does not use information received hereby to identify or contact you. The Internet-based services may include automatic updates and TSI may use device information, error reports, and malware reports to improve our software and services. We may also share it with others, such as hardware and software vendors. They may use the information to improve how their products run with TSI software. You may not use TSI Internet-based services in any way that could harm them or impair anyone else's use of them. You may not use the services to try to gain unauthorized access to any service, data, account or network by any means.
- 7. SCOPE OF LICENSE. The software is licensed, not sold. This agreement only gives you some rights to use the features included in the software edition you licensed. TSI reserves all other rights. Unless applicable law gives you more rights despite this limitation, you may use the software only as expressly permitted in this agreement. In doing so, you must comply with any technical limitations in the software that only allow you to use it in certain ways. You may not: a. work around any technical limitations in the software; b. reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble the software, except and only to the extent that applicable law expressly permits, despite this limitation; c. make more copies of the software than specified in this agreement or allowed by applicable law, despite this limitation; d. publish the software for others to copy; e. use the software in any way that is against the law; f. rent, lease or lend the software; or g. use the software for commercial software hosting services; g. the software is subject to United States export laws and regulations. You may not export the software without the written consent of TSI.
- 8. BACKUP COPY. If you acquired the software on a disc or other media, you may make one backup copy of the media. You may use it only to reinstall the software on the licensed device. If you acquired and downloaded the software online, you may make one copy of the software on a disc or other media in order to install the software on the licensed device. You may also use it to reinstall the software on the licensed device. If you acquired and downloaded software online with Click-to–Run technology, you will not be able to make a copy of the software on a disc or other media. Instead you may download the software online again only to reinstall the software on the licensed device.

 9. DOCUMENTATION. Any person that has valid access to your licensed device or internal network may copy and
- 9. DOCUMENTATION. Any person that has valid access to your licensed device or internal network may copy and use the documentation for your internal, reference purposes.
- 10. UPGRADE OR CONVERSION. To upgrade or convert software, you must first be licensed for the software that is eligible for the upgrade or conversion. Upon upgrade or conversion, this agreement takes the place of the agreement for the software you upgraded or converted from. After you upgrade or convert, you may no longer use the software you upgraded or converted from.
- 11. PROOF OF LICENSE. If you acquired the software on a disc or other media, your proof of license is the genuine TSI certificate of authenticity label with the accompanying genuine product key and your proof of purchase. If you purchased and downloaded the software online, your proof of license is the genuine TSI product key for the software which you received with your purchase and your proof of purchase from an authorized electronic supplier of genuine TSI software. Proof of purchase may be subject to verification by your merchant's records. If you upgrade or convert the software, your proof of license is the genuine proof of license for the software you upgraded or converted from; and the genuine proof of license for the software you upgraded or converted to.
- 12. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This agreement any addendum or amendment included with the software, and the terms for supplements, updates, Internet-based services and support services that you use, are the entire agreement for the software and support services.
- 13. APPLICABLE LAW. If you acquired the software in the United States, Utah State law governs the interpretation of this agreement and applies to claims for breach of it, regardless of conflict of laws principles. The laws of the state where you live govern all other claims, including claims under state consumer protection laws, unfair competition laws, and in tort. If you acquired the software in any other country, the laws of that country apply.
- 14. LIMITATION ON AND EXCLUSION OF DAMAGES. YOU CAN RECOVER FROM TSI AND ITS SUPPLIERS ONLY DIRECT DAMAGES UP TO THE AMOUNT YOU PAID FOR THE SOFTWARE. YOU CANNOT RECOVER ANY OTHER DAMAGES, INCLUDING CONSEQUENTIAL, LOST PROFITS, SPECIAL, INDIRECT OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES. This limitation applies to anything related to the software, services, content (including code) on third party Internet sites, or third party programs; and claims for breach of contract, breach of warranty, guarantee or condition, strict liability, negligence, or other tort to the extent permitted by applicable law. It also applies even if repair, replacement or a refund for the software does not fully compensate you for any losses; or TSI knew or should have known about the possibility of the damages. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you. They also

may not apply to you because your country may not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental, consequential or other damages.

WARRANTY

A. LIMITED WARRANTY. If you follow the instructions, the software will perform substantially as described in the TSI materials that you receive in or with the software.

B. TERM OF WARRANTY; WARRANTY RECIPIENT; LENGTH OF ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES. THE LIMITED WARRANTY COVERS THE SOFTWARE FOR ONE YEAR AFTER ACQUIRED BY THE FIRST USER. IF YOU RECEIVE SUPPLEMENTS, UPDATES, OR REPLACEMENT SOFTWARE DURING THAT YEAR, THEY WILL BE COVERED FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE WARRANTY OR 30 DAYS, WHICHEVER IS LONGER. If the first user transfers the software, the remainder of the warranty will apply to the recipient. TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES, GUARANTEES OR CONDITIONS LAST ONLY DURING THE TERM OF THE LIMITED WARRANTY. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so these limitations may not apply to you. They also might not apply to you because some countries may not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty, guarantee or condition lasts.

- C. EXCLUSIONS FROM WARRANTY. This warranty does not cover problems caused by your acts (or failures to act), the acts of others, or events beyond TSI's reasonable control.
- D. REMEDY FOR BREACH OF WARRANTY. TSI WILL REPAIR OR REPLACE THE SOFTWARE AT NO CHARGE. IF TSI CANNOT REPAIR OR REPLACE IT, TSI WILL REFUND THE AMOUNT SHOWN ON YOUR RECEIPT FOR THE SOFTWARE. IT WILL ALSO REPAIR OR REPLACE SUPPLEMENTS, UPDATES AND REPLACEMENT SOFTWARE AT NO CHARGE. IF TSI CANNOT REPAIR OR REPLACE THEM, IT WILL REFUND THE AMOUNT YOU PAID FOR THEM, IF ANY. YOU MUST UNINSTALL THE SOFTWARE AND RETURN ANY MEDIA AND OTHER ASSOCIATED MATERIALS TO TSI WITH PROOF OF PURCHASE TO OBTAIN A REFUND. THESE ARE YOUR ONLY REMEDIES FOR BREACH OF THE LIMITED WARRANTY. E. CONSUMER RIGHTS NOT AFFECTED. YOU MAY HAVE ADDITIONAL CONSUMER RIGHTS UNDER YOUR LOCAL LAWS, WHICH THIS AGREEMENT CANNOT CHANGE.

WHERE ALLOWED BY YOUR LOCAL LAWS, TSI EXCLUDES IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND NON-INFRINGEMENT. If your local laws give you any implied warranties, guarantees or conditions, despite this exclusion, your remedies are described in the Remedy for Breach of Warranty clause above, to the extent permitted by your local laws.
